Are post offices that are equipped to renew motor vehicle licences allowed to refuse to do so if there are outstanding e-toll accounts related to the vehicle in question; if so, under what circumstances is this permitted?

REPLY:

I have been advised by the South African Post Office as follows:-

No. Outstanding e-toll accounts are not described as infringements in the current Service Level Agreement with the Department of Transport. Further, the eNatis system is not set-up to pick up outstanding e-toll payments as it is with other infringements.
