LETTER OF ENGAGEMENT TO ADDRESS THE ONGOING SEWAGE POLLUTION PROBLEM WITHIN THE DIEP RIVER AND MILNERTON LAGOON – REQUEST FOR INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION OUR REF: L9/BD/04 YOUR REF: UNKNOWN

- 1. Our letter dated 25 February 2020 bears reference.
- 2. We herewith wish to confirm that we have arranged to meet with city officials on Wednesday, 18 March 2020.



- 3. In anticipation of our meeting on the 18th of March 2020, we would wish to request that the city provide us with the following documentation:
 - a) A copy of the Water Quality Monitoring Reports for Potsdam, for the past 12 months;
 - b) A copy of the current Water Use Licence for the Potsdam Wastewater Treatment Works;
 - c) A copy of the Potsdam Environmental Management System Plan, as per point 2.1.1 of the Potsdam Water Use Licence;
 - d) A copy of the Potsdam Emergency Preparedness Plan, as per point 2.3.1 of the Potsdam Water Use Licence;
 - e) A copy of the Potsdam General Operational and Impact Management Plan, as per point 5 of the Potsdam Water Use Licence;
 - f) A copy of the Diep River Pollution Abatement Plan;
 - g) A copy of the Notice issued by the Department of Water and Sanitation to the City of Cape Town, requesting compliance with the Potsdam Wastewater Treatment Works Water Use Licence;
 - h) A copy the city's action plan to be sent to the Department of Water and Sanitation by 13 March 2020, before our meeting on 18 March 2020.
- 4. Furthermore, we would also wish to request that the city provide us with the following information:
 - a) Clarify how many outlets are exiting the Diep River;
 - b) Advise whom the current Waste Management Control Officer of the Potsdam Wastewater Treatment Works are;
 - c) The Potsdam Wastewater Treatment Works was found to be non-compliant in February 2019, why has it taken over a year to fix the problems and how will operational problems be resolved quicker going forward;



- 5. We appreciate that we will be able to meet with city officials on 18 March 2020 and we look forward to a collegial and fruitful meeting.
