TAKE NOTICE THAT application will be made on behalf of the abovementioned applicant to the above Honourable Court on a date to be allocated at 10:00 or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, for an order in the following terms:

- That the decision of the first respondent to award a generation licence to the second respondent under application number NERSA-1532172523-62476 ("the first impugned decision") be reviewed and set aside.
- That the decision of the first respondent to award a generation licence to the third respondent under application number NERSA-1532172523-62559 ("the second impugned decision") be reviewed and set aside.
- That the decision of the first respondent to award a generation licence to the fourth respondent under application number NERSA-1532172523-62555 ('the third impugned decision") be reviewed and set aside.
- 4. That the first, second and third impugned decisions (collectively referred to as "the impugned decisions") be remitted to the first respondent for reconsideration in terms of section 8(1)(c)(i) of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act 3 of 2000.
- 5. That the first respondent be ordered to pay the costs of this application.
- 6. That the second to eighth respondents be ordered to pay the costs jointly and severally with the first respondent, only in the event of opposition by them.

7. Further and/or alternative relief.

TAKE NOTICE FUTHER that the accompanying affidavit of **STEFANIE FICK** together with the annexures thereto as well as supporting affidavits filed herewith will be used in support of this application.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE:

- a) that in terms of Rule 53(1)(a) of the Uniform Rules of Court, the respondents are called upon to show cause why the decisions referred to above should not be reviewed and set aside;
- that in terms of Rule 53(1)(b) of the Uniform Rules of Court, the first respondent is called upon to despatch to the Registrar of the above Honourable Court, within 15 (fifteen) days after service of the Notice of Motion upon it, the records of all documents and all electronic records that relate to the making of the decisions referred to above, together with such reasons as the first respondent is by law required or desires to give or make, and notify the applicant that it has been done;
- c) in terms of Uniform Rule 53(4), the applicant may within 10 (ten) days of receipt of the record from the Registrar, amend, add to or vary the terms of its Notice of Motion and supplement the Founding Affidavit, by delivery of a notice and accompanying Supplementary Founding Affidavit.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if any of the respondents intend to oppose the relief sought in the Notice of Motion, such respondents are required:

- a) within 15 (fifteen) days of delivery of this Notice of Motion or any amendment thereto as contemplated in Uniform Rule 53(4), to deliver a notice to the applicant's attorneys that such respondents intend to oppose, and in such notice to appoint an address referred to in Rule 6(5)(b) of the Uniform Rules of Court within 15 kilometres of the office of the Registrar of this Honourable Court at which the respondents will accept notice and service of all process in these proceedings;
- b) within 30 (thirty) days of the expiry of the time referred to in Uniform Rule 53(4), to deliver any affidavits as the respondents may desire in answer to the allegations made by the Applicant.
